### Campaign Fund Resolution.

The Democratic State Central Committee has adopted the following resolution in regard to the raising of funds for the national campaign:

"Resolved, That each member of the State Central Committee representing a parish or city ward is hereby instructed to organize, at noon of September 26, this year, a Democratic club in each ward of his parish or in each precinct of his city ward, with a view principally of raising funds to carry on the national Democratic campaign, said funds to be forwarded to Louisiana's Democratic National Committee as soon as possible.

"That each member of this committee elected at large from congressional districts shall lend his active assistance to the parish and city ward members within his district towards affecting the organization of said Democratic clubs.

"That on or before October 16, 1908, each member of this committee representing a parish or city ward shall report to Secretary Robert S. Landry, of this committee, the number of clubs organized within the territory he represents and the amount of money forwarded from each club within his territory to the State National Committeeman, Hon. Robert Ewing, and the Secretary of this committee shall tabulate these reports and publish them in the New Orleans daily papers as soon after October 16 as practicable.

"That a copy of this resolution be mailed by the Secretary to each absent member of this committee."—Resolution offered by Hon. Henry L. Gueydan.

On Thursday of last week the amount raised by New Orleans States was \$8,437.24, by Shreveport \$400.
