MALE STENOGRAPHERS AND TYPEWRITERS IN DEMAND.

The United States Civil Service Commission announces that while it has no difficulty in securing sufficient female stenographers and typewriters to meet the needs of the department at Washington, the supply of male eligibles has not been equal to the demand. Young men who are at least 18 years of age and who are willing to accept the usual entrance salaries, which are \$840 and \$900 a year, have excellent opportunities for appointment. While the entrance salaries are low, advancement is reasonably rapid to those meriting it. The examinations, which

any competent stenographer could be able to pass, are held each month in the year, except December, at the principal cities of the United States.

Y., New Orleans, La.; or Old Customhouse, St. Louis, Mo.

The Missouri Pacific - Iron Mountain have placed an order with the Baldwin Locomotive Works, of Philadelphia, for 25 huge locomotives. They will be of the Mikado type and will be used in freight service. In every detail these engines will represent the latest effort in locomotive construction. The light weight of the engine and tender will be 311,900 pounds, and when in working condition and ready for service the total weight will run close to 400,000 pounds. The weight on the drivers will be 209,000 pounds and the locomotives will have a tractive force of 50,170 pounds. The specifications call for cylinders 27 inches by 30 inches, and the boiler pressure requirement is 170 lbs. to the square inch. The total length of the engine will be 78 feet 4 1-2 inches, and they will measure 15 feet 5 1-2 inches from the rail to the top of the smokestack. They will be equipped with Schmidt superheaters, a recent invention for increasing the power of steam, and they will also have electric headlights and electric cab lights. The railroad expects to receive the first of the engines by the 15th of February.
