

Hindenburg drove Russians across the Dvina north of Pinsk.
British submarine E-7 lost in Dardanelles.
German cavalry reached the railway at Motodechno.
English prize court condemned seized American meat cargoes.
Entente allies demanded that Bulgaria declare her position.
Russian duma prorogued.
