## Signal Service Weather Signs.

### INDICATIONS.

No 1, white flag—clear or fair weather.  
No 2, blue flag—rain or snow.  
No 3, white flag, black center—cold wave.  
No 4, black triangular flag—temperature.

When No 4, or triangular black flag is placed over No 1 or white flag, it means clear and warmer, when placed below it means clear and colder. When placed over the blue flag it means warmer rain, and when below, rain and colder. When the white flag is over the blue flag it means fair followed by rain, and when the blue flag is over the white flag, it means rain followed by fair weather.
