SIDE WALK ORDINANCE dinance relative to the

Martinville, St. Mertin Perish, Lo. Be it ordained by the Town Countries in re

section assembled;

That it shall be the duly of each and every property holder along the streets of St. Martinville to construct opposite to and along their properties, plank side walks, consisting of planks four feet long, one and a half lineh thick and six inches wife to be consisted. inches wide, to be placed erceswise on three stringers three inches by four inches thick, on all streets, except Main Street; on which Main street from Rail Bond Avenue to Borard street, the side walk shall be no less than ten feet wide and to be made aither of brick, concrete or coment, or planks not to be less than one and a half such thick, six inches wide and ten feet leng, and to be laid crosswise on four stringers three by four, and except also on Bridge except from Main street to the entrance steps of the Catholic graveyard, where said sideswill-

Main street to the entrance steps of the Cathelie graveyard, where said sidewalk shall be not less than six feet wide built of plank one and a half inch thick six inches gride and six feet long.

Be it further ordained; that the Mavor be and is hereby invested with the power to order the construction of said side walks or the side walks on such streets as the City Council may decide to commence at once. streets as the City Council may decide to commence at once, and he shall at once proceed and give to the owners of the property holders of such streets of the Town of St. Martin-ville a notice of thirty days, in writing, if he be a resident of St. Martin parish, and forty five days if he be a non-resident of St. Martin Parish, ordering said property holders within east time to build east side waits in front of their respective properties, at their costs. In case of failure on the part of the property holders to build said side waits within the time required by this ordinance, that the same shall be done at the expense of the owner of said property according to the charter of the Corporation, the cost of which shall be recovered as stated in the charter.

Be it further ordained etc. That it is

Be it further ordained etc. That it hereby declared to be the duty of an owner of town property to keep in a pair the side walks in front of and alo his property; and he shall repair or side walk upon a notice in writing

elde walk.

Be it further ordained, That all now elde walks shall be built on a level and that all construction of new elde walks as well as the repairing of those new azisting shall be made under the immediate supervision of the Mayor or some councilman appainted by him.

Be it further ordained etc. That in cases in which repairs are only to be made that they must be of the best material for the purpose and made in a manner estimatory to a majority of the members of the council, always under the supervision of the Mayor, in default thereof said repairs shall be made at the rest of the property owner as already above provided.
