The yield of the crop of rice which is now being harvested is extremely disappointing to the farmer, and is quite a surprise to those who thought they knew something of the appearance of a rice crop. Rice that was apparently good, and was estimated to yield 18 to 20 sacks to the acre, are giving 10 and 12, and in some places less than that. The yield generally is small, and we hardly think that this year's crop in this parish will be much more than half that of last year. In other sections of the rice belt the same result is reported which means an entirely short crop, and in view of this fact, it might be well for our rice planters to hold on to their rice and not rush it to the market. Under present conditions the rice ought to command a better price than present quotations, and if held, will surely have a tendency to higher the price. Mr. Henry Rebot representing a Lake Charles mill was here this week, and bought several car loads. All our rice should be sold right here, and the planters should make an effort to interest the buyers to come here and bid for their crop instead of shipping to a market where it gets entirely out of their control, and they stand at the mercy of brokers and classers who make several grades and qualities of the same rice.

ARTESIAN WELLS.

Whatever the prospects for oil may be near Sulphur, the people of that vicinity are certain of artesian water. Col. W. L. Holton has just completed two 10 inch artesian wells on his farm purchased from J. P. Hampton and others, three and a half miles southwest of Sulphur. The wells are 520 feet deep and water flows from them fourteen feet above the level of the ground. These are the first artesian wells completed in that neighborhood, and west Calcasieu rice farmers are correspondingly elated.—Lake Charles American.
