Men Are Eating Hay

ALFALFA IS BEING LARGELY USED ON TABLES IN THE WEST. IT IS GROUND WITH WHEAT. THE COOKED PRODUCE IS SAID TO BE MORE NUTRITIOUS THAN MEAT AND IS A REMEDY FOR INSOMNIA AND STOMACH TROUBLES.

Six families out of every ten in Nebraska are eating hay in the shape of bread, biscuits, pancakes and pastries. Time was, and it was not so many years ago, when a stock joke in the West ran something like this: "You can do this or that but you can't eat hay." The joke has turned and today the vast majority of families in the West are eating Alfalfa, until recently considered food for cattle, horses and hogs. They are going even further and taking a powder made from the blossoms of the plant as medicine for insomnia, indigestion and stomach troubles.

ALFALFA FLOUR IS CHEAP

To make the alfalfa meal and flour the grass is cut early in June and at a time when it is full bloom. It is cured in the sun and, if possible, without being wet by rain. When thoroughly dry the leaves are stripped from the stalks and these leaves, mixed with wheat at a ratio of one-third alfalfa and two-thirds wheat are ground into a coarse meal. This meal is used for cakes as well as for a breakfast food. That desired for bread and pastry is ground still finer and bolted, and when placed upon the market can be sold for about 80 cents per sack of 50 pounds, whereas a good trade of wheat flour will retail at \$1.50 to \$1.75 per sack of the same weight. So far the only thing that can be regarded as objectionable about the alfalfa meal or flour is the color. Instead of being white it is a bright emerald green. This color remains through the cooking process, and a plate of hot biscuits or a 'plate of cakes' come to the table as green as the grass of the field.

MORE NUTRITIOUS THAN WHEAT

So far as being nutritious, the alfalfa product has the wheat and corn badly beaten, and experiments show that a man who eats alfalfa products can work longer and harder, experiencing less fatigue than a man who makes a meal out of meat. Then, too, it is a medicine in a way, as its acts upon the nerves, and Omaha doctors have commenced prescribing it as a remedy for insomnia. For the nerves, the alfalfa hay comes to the consumer in another form. The blossoms are gathered just at the time when they are in full bloom. Like the hay, they are dried without moisture, and when bone dry they are ground to a fine powder, which is a light blue. This powder is made into tablets and constitutes a medicine that, while it will not cure all the ills, will play havoc with insomnia, indigestion and all manner of stomach difficulties.—Williamsport, (Pa.) Grit.

Professional Seiners Arrested.

Assumption Pioneer.

Another interesting chapter in the case of the people of this parish against the professional seiners operating in Lake Verret, came to pass this week. Reports reached here last Monday that the gang of professional seiners from Morgan City, who were notified a few days ago to discontinue their work in Assumption, were as busy as ever with their big seine, and armed with their license issued by the State Game Commission, they ignored the command of the parish authorities.

District Attorney Gilbert on learning of the presence of professional fishermen in the lake made affidavits before Justice of the Peace H. Joe Verret, against the seiners. Thursday morning Deputy Sheriff Adam Landry went on the Lake and returned with the following, who were charged with violating the seining ordinance of this parish: Gus Presenback, Juliau Rock, Jules Hotard, Jos. Solar and Arthur Rock; the latter for violating the Game Law.

The men were placed under a \$50 bond, and they immediately furnished the bond through Mr. Guillot, cashier of the Bank of Assumption, who acted for parties in Morgan City. The party of fisherman left immediately for their respective homes.
