The Demonstration Train.

On Tuesday May 7th., the Louisiana State Demonstration train will visit Breaux Bridge, St. Martinville and New Iberia. This train is operated under the joint auspices of the Louisiana State University, State Board of Health, State Department of Education, the United States Department of Agriculture and various railroads in the state.

The live stock exhibit on the demonstration train this year will be the most complete in the history of this means of placing object lessons before the people of the rural districts of the state. The stations purchased from the owners at the state fair in Shreveport last year the Champion Berkshire Gilt which beside taking all prizes in her class took all prizes for being the best animal on the grounds. This gilt is 10 months old and weighs 300 pounds and will be exhibited to visitors to the train interested in hog raising. A comparative exhibit will be made of full blooded Poland China hogs, with half-blooded hogs of the same class and with scrub hogs of the same age and condition so as to illustrate the effects of blood and breeding in that animal. The feed record of these hogs will be exhibited in connection with the comparison. The train will carry a high grade steer three years old weighing 1400 lbs. which will be placed in comparison with the scrub steer for the illustration of the advantages of blood and breeding in this class of animal life. The train will carry the Jersey cow for all-milk purposes with record of production and feeding. There will be two beef strains, the Herford and the Angus represented and also the Red Poll that combines both the beef strain and the milk production. Records will be shown how the animal if fed and treated for the milk production and fattened for the beef purposes. There will be shown an Angus calf 5 months and weighing 400 lbs. and as large as the average scrub 2-year old. These specimens are not secured from northern or western states but the actual product of breeding and feeding at the experiment stations in this state, and are fair illustrations of what can be accomplished if the same care is given them by the farmer as in the case of the experiment station authorities. Along with the animal exhibit will be shown the model dipping vat now so popular in some sections of the state in the eradication of the cattle tick, the greatest enemy to cattle in process of raising for any purpose. The miniature will show the relative proportions of the regulation vat and all the conveniences and safeguards that should attach to this device to insure cheap operation and no obnoxious effects to surrounding animal and vegetable life. Computations will be made by the lecturers on the train to prove the wisdom of scientific breeding and feeding in stock of all kinds and its effect on the value of the animal to the producer in dollars and cents of additional market value or better product for home consumption. A full demonstration of the results attained by the Boys' Corn Clubs, the Boys Hog Clubs, and the Girls' Canning Clubs will be shown on the train under the auspices of the Agricultural Extension Work Department of the University. A complete home-canning plant will be in operation and on exhibit on the train and the women of the state are particularly invited to see this exhibit for it means the end of waste in the domestic household and the dawn of a full larder under any

and all conditions. It also represents a remunerative industry if the surplus is placed on the market. The canning of Tomatoes by the canning clubs has proven a success, and in fact all forms of fruit and vegetation can be conserved indefinitely through the cheap and effective household canning plant. It offers immense possibilities to the housewives of the state and is well worthy of their special attention.

The State Department of Education is very deeply interested in the demonstration train which will be sent out by the Louisiana State University the first week in March. Speakers representing the Department of Education will accompany the train upon its entire trip.

The Department will have something like one-third or one-half of a coach in its exhibit, and the following are some of the items which constitute the exhibit:

1. Single school desks.
2. The hyloplate blackboard.
3. A model of the Stiles Sanitary Closet for country schools.
4. A model four-room country school building.
5. A drinking fountain for large schools having waterworks.
6. Drawings and specifications of drinking fountain for country schools.
7. A modern sanitary heater.
8. Photographs of consolidated school buildings.
9. Photographs of sections of good roads.
10. Photographs of school transfers filled with school children.
11. Photographs of a few of the best high school buildings.
12. Photographs of some of the best New Orleans school buildings.
13. Photographs of buildings of the state institutions.
14. Exhibits from the agricultural schools.
