ANT REMEDY.

The following is a tried and true recipe for driving away ants of all kinds:

Equal parts of tartar emetic and sugar. Mix dry, then moisten with water to the consistency of syrup and put on a dish in the runway of the ants. They will eat very freely of it and fail to return for a long time, or perhaps for the season.

The dish may be set away when dry. When again needed add water and a little more sugar, and it is ready for use. The one dish may be used several times. Great care should be observed in order that children do not get at the tartar emetic preparation, as it is poisonous.—Mary L. Bull, Domestic Science, University Farm, St.
