2. Rapid and economical gains are made by hogs.
3. Labor and expense are saved in harvesting and marketing the corn crop.
4. Crib space is saved because corn that is hogged-off does not have to be stored.
5. The corn crop is fed in the field where grown, thus the plant food contained in the crop is, to a large extent, returned to the soil.
6. The manure produced by the hogs is evenly scattered over the land.
