Important Decision.

On Monday last the Supreme Court of Louisiana, in session in New Orleans, through Justice N. C. Blanchard, handed a decision which affirms the judgment of the lower court of which Judge Lee, in the case of the Nona Mills, of Leesville, declared unconstitutional the act prohibiting the use of checks or tickets at plantations and stores issued to employes.
