LOUISIANA ELECTION

TAX AMENDMENT WINS BY SMALL MARGIN.

RING LEADERS ARE BEATEN

Only Six Parishes in State Gave Majorities Against it. Sanders' Vote Will be About 60,000 and Pharr's Less than 10,000.

New Orleans—Late returns indicate that the constitutional amendment providing for the consolidation of the seven tax offices of Orleans won out by about 2,500 majority.

Only five parishes in the State gave majorities against the amendment—Orleans, Jefferson, St. John, Lafourche and St. Martin. Every other parish voted for the amendment almost solidly, with the exception of East Baton Rouge and St. Charles, where the vote was close. While the total vote cast for the heads of the state ticket will approximate 70,000, the total vote cast on the tax amendment will barely reach 50,000.

This shows unusual interest in the constitutional amendments, because, as a rule, they are ignored by a large proportion of the voters.

The other four amendments, relating to the Secretary of State's salary and the railroad and corporation legislation, were carried by an almost unanimous vote.

WORLD'S SKATING RECORDS.
New Figures for 1,500 and 500 Metres Made at Davos.

Two world's records at skating saw the light in the recent championships of the world held at Davos, Switzerland. Four events comprised the meet—500, 1,500 and 10,000 metres—and these attracted the best skaters in the world.

Oscar Mathisen, of Christiania, captured the title, as he won three out of the four. In the 1,500 metres the Norwegian won by about three seconds, his time being 2 minutes 20.5 seconds, and it was a new mark for the world, beating the old one of 2 minutes 22.3 seconds by Poestlund at Davos in February, 1900. Mathisen maintained a speed of about 11.6 yards a second. This distance was 109 metres short of a mile, and allowing that the skater would slow down for the remaining distance he would at the worst do the mile in 2 minutes 32 seconds, figures which easily would eclipse anything yet made on skates on a circular track.

Mathisen's time for 5,000 metres was 8 minutes 55.3 seconds, of 18 seconds slower than the world's record by Eden in 1894. But when Mathisen skated the ice was covered with water. Mathisen won the 10,000 metres in 18 minutes 1.45 seconds, Thomson of Sweden, being second with 18 minutes 4 seconds.

The 500 metres was won by Wikander, of Helsingfors in 44.4 seconds, and in this he beat both Mathisen and Oeholm, who had the week before won the European championship. The time equaled the record by Gundersen in 1906, but in subsequent trials Wikander reduced the record to 44.25 seconds and this made the second world's mark for the meet.—New York Sun.


