The minutee of the meeting held Feb 4th, 1886, were read and approved.
The Committee appointed to luvestgate the alleged closing of 13 th street by T. N. Conner usked for further time to report which was granted. The same committee was aiso instructed to Investigate the alieged closing of certain streete in the north-eastern part of the elty, and to report at the uext regular meeting.
The following ordinance was then Introduced and adopled :

ORDINANOE NO. 609.
An ordinance probibiting the removal of ang frame bullding situated within the fire diatriet of Monroe from any one point theroln to any other polnt within and distriet-the purpose hereof being to rid entirely the said "Distrie" of all frame boildings, and thas further protect life and property in the Clity of Monroe :
Be it ordalned by the Mayor and Cits Council of Monroe, that, heron after, the removal of any frame buildlag eltuated within the Fire Diatriet of the City of Monroe from any one point therein to any oft point in eald Dietriet be and the. hereby prohisited.

Dit rurtive ordalned, that whover thall vilalate the provisiont of this over thail violate the provisions of this
Ordinance shall be faed in the sum of not lew than *50, and not more than, sero; to be tmposed by the City Recordee on the complatat of any officer of the Olityor any clitizens of said City and a dae pioor thereof and in detault of pyrment of fine to be Imprisoned in the City Calaboose for not less than TO and not more than 250 days, and sontenced to work on the public atreets of the City at the rate of one dollar per day unth the fine imposed be paite. Approved.
