TAX SALES

BY VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY VESTED
in me by the Constitution and Laws of the
State of Louisiana, I will sell at the principal
front-door of the Courthouse of the parish of
St. Landry, in the town of Opelousas, in which
the Civil District Court of said parish is held,
within the legal hours for judicial sales, begin-
ning at 11 o'clock A. M., on

and continuing on Monday and each succeeding
day until the said sales are completed, all
movable and immovable property on which
taxes are now due to the State of Louisiana
and parish of St. Landry, to enforce collection
of all taxes assessed in the year 1882,
together with the interest thereon from
the thirty-first day of December, 1882, at
the rate of eight per cent per annum and all
