BY VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY VESTED
in me by the Constitution and Laws of the
State of Louisiana, I will sell at the principal
front door of the Courthouse of the parish of
St. Landry, in the town of Opelousas, in which
the Civil District Court and parish is held,
within the legal hours for judicial sales, begin-
