The monthly fees, payable quarterly in advance, by each Cadet, shall be as follows: Board and tuition for five months, \$12.50. Laundry and mending, 1.50. Fuel and lights, 1.00. Medical attendance and medicines, 2.00. Total, per month, \$19.00.

Prof. J. W. NICHOLSON, the Senior Professor of the Faculty, will act as President until one is elected. No distinctions shall be made between Cadets, whether boarders in or out of the University. Cadets shall be required to purchase their own text books and provide themselves with the uniform designated by the regulations.

It is the intention of the Board to proceed immediately with the organization of the Agricultural and Mechanical departments. To this end it has secured the services of experienced and competent instructors.
