

## IMMENSE POWER NEEDED.

Life and Motion to be Among the Characteristic of the Louisiana Purchase Exposition.

Several times the amount of power employed or required at any former Exposition will be used at the World's Fair here. The policy of the management is to encourage life and motion in exhibits and ample provision is being made in the power plant which is to be installed in the western end of the Machinery building. Present estimates place this amount at 22,000 horse power. The Directors of Exhibits, Frederick J. V. Skiff, in a recent report to President Francis, says:

"Letters have been addressed to exhibitors in machinery at previous expositions, requesting an expression of their willingness to participate in the Universal Exposition at St. Louis, and the replies have been in the highest degree satisfactory, and indicate that practically all who exhibited there desire to do so at St. Louis, but on a much larger scale. A circular of instructions is being prepared for general distribution, descriptive of the purposes and of the general plan and scope of the Department of Machinery. It will reach not only the makers of machinery and machine appliances but also those interested in the machinery trade, it being the purpose to create a widespread interest and a sentiment favorable to the Exposition. The Chief, in his contact with machinery people, finds that the granting of free power and space appeals not only to exhibitors but to the general public in a forceful way. He reports: 'The people see that we are not asking for National and State appropriations, and then exacting fees from the very class for the special benefit of which the Exposition professes to organize and theoretically exist'."

### A Happy Compromise.

Observing the extortions of the meat trust, the Manufacturers Record reprints a table giving the per cent of nutrient of different foods which makes a great showing for the Louisiana cereal and stamps it at once as the food par excellence of opponents of the octopus. The man who dines on sirloin steak and eggs, potatoes and onions may imagine he is having a sumptuous repast; whereas he is absorbing only from 12 to 40 per cent of nutriment.

From this must also be deducted the amount of waste which in the case of sirloin runs as high as 19.5 per cent and in no kind of meat is less than 12. Fried chicken and roast turkey, no matter how much they tempt the appetite, have only 27.8 per cent of nutriment, further reduced by 38.4 per cent of refuse. Going on to an extreme example, the man who eats shad, planked or unplanked, gets but 29.4 per cent of nutriment of which 50.1 per cent is refuse, not to speak of the precious time lost in picking out the bones. Really, he is starving himself to death by degrees while in the midst of apparent plenty.

Turning at once from the contemplation of such a dire spectacle, note the happy condition of the man who lives rationally upon a vegetable diet—oatmeal 92.4 per cent of nutrients; peas 87.7;

rice, 87.6; beans, 87.4 and no waste whatever. Here, indeed, can one dine royally, not to say sumptuously, and yet reduce the world's provisions but little in bulk. Perhaps you have tried an exclusively diet and imagined that it palled on your stomach. Not so, your appetite was more easily satisfied because of the great preponderance of nutrients.

It may be noticed that oatmeal tops rice a little in nutritive qualities; but oatmeal is also in the grip of a trust which puts it out of action and leaves rice at the top. In old Louisiana, however, we cook rice with the un-nutritive but palatable chicken and pour over it likewise tempting brown gravy and find it not only the most nutritious but the most palatable dish in the world a combination possible with no other vegetable in the front rank of nutritives.




