### An Ohio Man's Air Ship.

Alonson Wood, a retired builder, and an inventor of prominence of Toledo, O., has applied for a patent on a flying machine 42 feet high, 30 feet wide, and weighing about two tons. It is a departure from other machines consisting of tilted panes, or propellers, which are made to revolve around a central shaft. These panes have a total area of 1,200 square feet, and will be driven by a gasoline motor. The engine is ten feet square, and the lifting capacity is estimated at 12 tons. Other propellers will drive the machine through the air at a velocity which Mr. Wood estimates at a mile a minute. Mr. Wood is the inventor of the roller coaster and sold his rights there in for \$80,000.

Officials of the Great Exposition Move Into Their New Quarters To Remain Until After The Exposition.

No Exposition ever had such beautiful quarters for its officers as those into which the working force of the Louisiana Purchase Exposition have moved this week. The work of transplanting the executive departments has been going on for several days and all the officers are now comfortably installed at the permanent buildings on the Exposition grounds. These buildings are not only commodious but fire proof and richly built of pink Missouri granite and cut limestone. The buildings cost \$740,000 and were built for the Washington University, which recently came into a liberal endowment. It became necessary for the World's Fair to require the entire grounds of the University which embrace 110 acres, and an agreeable arrangement was made with the University officials for the use of the buildings which have just been completed. President Francis, Secretary Steven, Director of Exhibits Skiff and all his department chiefs, as well as the Department of Publicity, will occupy the main Administration Building, which has a broad eastern frontage overlooking almost the entire World's Fair site. Directors of Works Taylor and his several chiefs of departments will occupy Busch Hall which is the southernmost of the group. The Cupples Hall No. 1 will be used principally for Exhibit.
