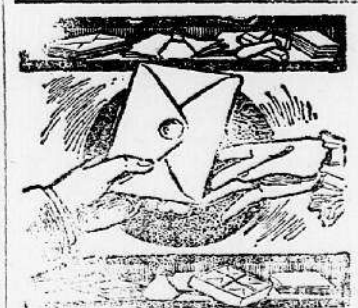

Democratic state convention to

received the gubernatorial nom-
