





NEW TRIAL FOR BATSON.

Supreme Court Has Given Edward Batson a New Trial.

By the decision of the supreme court, announced late Saturday in New Orleans. Albert Edward Batson gets another chance for his life and at least six months more of life. In accordance with the supreme court's dictum, it will be necessary to try Batson again from the beginning; to re-indict him and retrace all the steps which led to the jury's verdict in April.

The next regular grand jury meets in August. There is no likelihood that a special grand jury will be called, because it would avail nothing. Even if the indictment held good and he could be tried again immediately it would be impossible to proceed until the repairs to the court house are completed. The temporary building has no conveniences for criminal trials and it would, moreover, be almost suicidal to attempt the hearing of a lengthy case in the building during the hot weather.

It is possible that when the trial does begin great difficulty will be experienced in securing a so widely has the evidence in the case been read and discussed and his attorneys may be able to secure a change of venue on that ground to some other parish. Northern Race Riot.
"Southern outrages" are happening in the North with alarming frequency. Recently in the town of Eldorado, Ill., a race war broke out and "inoffensive colored citizens" were very badly treated. Homes of "colored citizens" who had offended no one were visited by white men. Shots were fired through the houses and the inmates were notified to leave for other parts. Rev. Peter Green, the spiritual director of the colored population, was not treated with the deference due his high calling and his house was stoned. The Normal and Industrial Institute for colored people was attacked and there is talk of moving the institution to some Southern State where the white people are disposed to accord the negroes fair treatment.—Lafayette Gazette.

To Regulate Gambling.
The Steidley bill to regulate gambling is as follows:
SECTION 1.—Be it enacted by the general assembly of the state of Louisiana that authority is hereby granted all municipal corporations to regulate within their corporate limits, gambling and gambling houses, including pool rooms and turf exchanges.
SECTION 2.—Be it further enacted that to make their ordinances effective in the exercise of the authority herein conferred, all municipalities shall have authority to prescribe such penalties for the violation of the other ordinances under their respective charters.


