

Being a close reader of your daily paper, and noticing particularly the many articles pro and con, relating to the present campaign, in which a deep interest seems to be manifest, the writer can not help but express his sentiments.

"Can you legislate a man or a community, dry?"

The question can readily be answered in the negative.

I remember of hearing the great Francis Murphy, a renowned temperance orator, state in a public address: "That the best prohibition is a man's own will power, and that you can never legislate a man dry."

I am willing to admit that liquor has been the downfall of many a man, and that it works in many instances a hardship on the family. Our present temperance orators are pursuing the wrong course. The writer is a temperance man according to the meaning of the word temperance, but he never was or never will be a teetotaler. The use of liquor has its advantages as well as its disadvantages, and if you would educate people how to use liquor, and when they do use it, to use nothing but the best quality. It seems to me that we are living in a liberal age, and because there are certain persons who are narrow minded enough to see "only good" from their standpoint, is no reason why they should prevent others from enjoying the luxuries of this life, so long as they keep within the bounds of decency.

The word, "prohibition" when carried to its full meaning, works a hardship. What right, according to divine law or legal authority, has a man to say to another: "Thou shall not drink?" or in other words, "I will see that you are deprived of your luxury." It seems to the writer that if this

were carried out, you impose a most tyrannical outrage. It is generally conceded that prohibition is a failure. Look to the states of Iowa, Kansas and Maine, and ask the people of these states what they think of prohibition.

Liquor is a refreshment in one sense of the word, and when used properly, has no more had effect on a person, than when that person eats his or hers three meals a day.

I could dwell on this subject much longer, but I fear Mr. Editor that I am intruding on your space, and will close by saying that the tendency of the present day is not to deprive a man of what he wants, but if his (?) "want" is wrong, we should try to convince him of it, and not say to him, "Thou shall not." We should reach the fallen by other channels.


