MAKING PREPARATIONS.
 The Old Soldiers Will Receive a Royal Welcome at their National Gathering. Special to the Record.
 Washington, D. C., Oct. 3.—The national capital is being being decked out in gala attire to an extent seldom before known in her history. From one end of the city to the other, on every hand, workmen may be seen putting up a bewildering array of bunting, flags and streamers, until the eye is sated with the varied display. Men who have attended other encampments of the G. A. R. are authority for the statement that the general decorations will fully come up to those of any other city and that the electrical display will far exceed anything of the kind attempted before. Not only are business streets and the houses on the line of parade decorated, but in all parts of the city, even to the suburbs, evidence of the patriotism of the citizens is blossoming out in a rainbow of color.
 The Committee on decoration and illumination has been very thorough in its work and has introduced several entirely new features. During the week of the encampment the dome of the national capitol will be illuminated with searchlights for the first time in its history. Commander-in-Chief Eli Terrence had requested that the capitol be lighted up while the veterans were in Washington, and the chiefs of departments put their heads together to evolve the most effective scheme of night decoration. It was decided that the glow of searchlights on the white marble dome would produce an unusual and striking effect, and the electrical engineers are now carrying the scheme into effect, using for the purpose the huge naval searchlights in vogue in Uncle Sam's ships of war.
