A GREAT DISADVANTAGE.

The change in the railroad schedule is causing a great inconvenience to the people of Jennings, especially so in the late arrival of the mail. The train carrying the mail is known as the Sunset Limited, and arrives in Jennings at 5:50 p. m., and often times the train is late. In a large number of instances that compels many people to wait for their mail until the next morning. Heretofore they could get their mail the same evening.

Now a move is on foot among the citizens to try and get the arrival of the mail changed, and instead of it being carried on train No. 9, try and have it arrive on train No. 5, which arrives at 3:04 p. m. A great deal of complaint is heard from the patrons of the office, owing to the late arrival of the evening mail.

The RECORD understands that a petition will be circulated asking the Superintendent of the Railway Mail Service at Fort Worth, Texas, requesting him (if it is within his power to do so) to change the arrival of the mail, and have it come on train No. 5, which arrives at 3:04 p. m. This will be greatly appreciated by the patrons of the Jennings post-office.

Mrs. E. N. Marsh.
Mrs. Marsh was born in Ashburnham, Mass., in 1844 and married Mr. E. N. Marsh Jan. 25 1868 in Waverley, Iowa. They resided in Iowa until 1887 when they removed to Jennings, La., and located 12 miles north of Jennings on Mamou Prairie where they have lived since that time. Mrs. Marsh died in Jennings, November 15th, 1902, of a combination of Catarrh and Typhoid Malaria fever. Besides her husband she leaves a daughter, Mrs. Frank Garrould, one son, a father, one sister and two brothers to mourn her loss. She lived an exemplary christian life and her death is felt by the entire neighborhood.
