WASHINGTON, D. C., Feb. 6.—Congressman Clardy, who has been elected to congress five times, and who will be the eastern and southern Missouri candidate for governor in 1888, says in a Sunday paper:

"My advice to young men is to keep out of politics, and I can speak from experience, as I have been fairly in the swim ever since I was of age. The same amount of energy and perseverance to succeed in politics, if devoted to any other profession in life, would procure him an enviable and permanent position in the ranks. Political success is a very shaky thing, and a man on the top rung of the ladder don't know when he will find himself down near the bottom. To a young man a seat in the congress of the United States seems to be worth years of trouble to obtain, but after he has been fairly elected and comes on here to Washington his ideas undergo radical change. He finds that he is after all only one of a great many; that he has to work harder than he ever did before, and that it takes just about all of his salary to make ends meet here and keep the pot boiling at home. When the time finally comes for him to be retired and some other fellow to step into his shoes, he goes home to find all his practice in the hands of the lucky fellows who have staid out of politics, and at the period of life when he ought to be enjoying the fruits of independence he has to curtail his expenses and knuckle down to hard work to retrieve his shattered fortunes."

The vote of 22 to 11, by which the upper pranch of the Missouri legislature decides to indefinitely postpone the submission question, kills that scheme for the next two years. This is to be regretted. Prohibition, whether provided for by organic or statute law, has not hitherto proven to be very effective in the states which have tried it. Nor is there any probability that Missouri would prove any exception to the general rule in this matter. There is no doubt, however, that a large number of the most intelligent citizens of this state desired to have the question of the adoption of a prohibition amendment submitted to a popular vote. Some of these persons would have voted against the amendment, perhaps. Others would have voted for it. The project might or might not be carried if the people were permitted to vote upon it. But the right of the people to be allowed to decide whether they would try prohibition or not is clear and undoubted.—Globe Democrat.
