#### Wheat Seeding

The question always comes up as to what time we should sow wheat to secure the best results. This can in no way be foretold but we do have a time of safest averages. In this latitude that time is from perhaps the last week in September till an equal date in October. It will be recalled that this did not happen to be the best time last year. It may not be the best time next

We should select the ears of good type and of medium to large size and that grows on strong, sturdy stalks. Seed gathered at this time should be hung up at once in a dry well ventilated place. #### SEED CORN

If corn is gathered now and properly dried before heavy frost there is no occasion for such loss on the part of anybody.
