The destruction of life and property at Omaha last week, the race war at Elaine, Ark, the hanging and burning of rapists in Louisiana, the disreputable conduct of citizens of Ardmore Okla, even tho the suppressors of the right of free speech for a United States Senator were of the I. W. W. stripe and oil workers and coal miners led on by pro-league parties, might all have been prevented and local disgrace averted by the suppression of leaders of such lawless bands in advance of an occasion for the exercise of their lawless propensities. We mean that every community has men and women and boys whose characters are inimical to good government and the eradication of such by communities in which they are known to exist will obviate such scenes as those mentioned and thousands of others which are not only humiliating to the orderly element, but which threaten life, property and of course, peace. But 'We suffer those ills we have rather than

fly to others we know not of' and take chances all against us when opportunity offers for innate desperadoes, sneaks, human coyotes and worse, the meek individual who is guilty of doing nothing nine tenths of the time and overdoing everything the other tenth of his earthly existence.

The solution of the serious problem is extinction of individuals whose lives are spent in idleness or in pursuits which add nothing whatever of value to a community; human Ospreys who wait until the fishing bird can be caught with something, pounce down on it and take away its earned provender and leave it to gather more grub wherever it can find it.

We do not wish to be understood as declining to make our pull on a rope attached to rapist or beastly debaucher of women, but we contend that some one knows of such characters, official knowledge of characters whose presence menaces, if not administration of law, then the morals of others older as well as younger, and the knowing one is derelict if disclosure is not forthcoming. Eradication of the roots of unlawful proceedings for the correction of unusual crimes and recognition of the guaranteed right of free speech and a free press, the only means of conveying to the public facts


