If there was a big fire in your town, a very bad and disastrous fire, and the water supply was short — would you still further cripple the work of the firemen by sprinkling your lawn?

But what has this got to do with Government Bonds?

Just this. If you and I place our money in the usual investments, or spend it for trivial things, we are crippling the work of the Army and Navy—"over there."

In other words, firemen at a big fire want water—soldiers in a big fight want guns—and guns cost money.

When there is a big fire, don't sprinkle your lawn; firemen need the water. When there is a big fight, don't hold on to your money, but loan it to the Government to buy the things the boys need "over there"—guns, ammunition, clothing, food.
