## OXEN DID GOOD SERVICE

**Sawyer farmer Keeps Four Oxen Three Years on 82 Bushels Ground Feed--Broke Several Hundred Acres With Them.**

J. B. Glider, a prosperous young Sawyer farmer, brot his four head of oxen to Minot Saturday, disposing of them for \$265. The animals weighed from 1905 to 1925 pounds and have done a lot of work for Mr. Glider during the past three years. He broke up and farmed seventy five acres on his own farm, besides breaking out over 200 acres for neighbors. During all of that time, Mr. Glider fed them only 82 bushels of ground feed, most of their sustenance coming from the prairie in the shape of hay and grass. The oxen cost him only a trifle over \$200 three years ago. Glider now affords a spanking team of horses, and realizes that its better to creep before one tries to walk.
