## BRIEF STATE NEWS

George H. Hollister, a Fargo bank-  
er, has been appointed state director  
for war savings campaign in North  
Dakota.

It took the jury at Bismarck only  
30 minutes to find Mrs. O'Hare guilty  
of interfering and attempting to ob-  
struct the recruiting and enlisting  
service in the United States army.

Anna Skieie of Upham, was arrest-  
ed last week on a charge of giving in-  
toxicated liquors to minors. At the  
preliminary hearing she was bound  
over to the district court.

Deering held a public reception in  
honor of Lieut. Howard Huston, a  
young man of that village who had  
been commissioned at the Second Of-  
ficers School at Fort Snelling.

The Grand Forks commercial club  
has decided to give financial back-  
ing to the proposed visit to North  
Dakota of the Camp Dodge military band. A  
tour of North and South Dakota is  
proposed by the band in January.

New coal mines are being opened  
up all along the Northern Pacific as  
a result of the coal shortage. North  
Dakota people will be compelled to  
use lignite coal if the present condi-  
tions continue.

The second week of January has  
been named by the State Food com-  
mittee as "Efficiency Week" during  
which time all social and civic clubs  
of the state will be asked to set aside  
social affairs for the discussion of  
food conservation.

A. D. Reid, formerly of Marmarth,  
now residing in Oregon, will soon be  
brought to Marmarth to answer to the  
charge of passing a worthless check  
for \$50. His accomplice is a thirteen-  
year-old daughter. He has also pass-  
ed worthless checks at other places.  
Posing as a Moose he would get a  
fellow member to endorse his check.

The famous Hebron wine case, in  
which a party of citizens were charged  
with illegally shipping a carload of  
wine which has for almost two years  
aged in the cellars of the Morton  
county court house, was kicked out of  
the United States court yesterday  
when U. S. District Attorney Hildreth,  
for the prosecution, moved for a dis-  
missal after the trial of Philip Bender,  
alleged agent in the case, had begun.

A terrible accident occurred last  
Thursday night at about 8 o'clock  
when Brily Douglas, or near Carlyle,  
one of the pioneer settlers of the  
Golden Valley, had his skull crushed  
in and brains dashed out when his  
Ford car, driven by his son, Fred,  
struck the back end of a load of lum-  
ber at a sharp hill one and a half  
miles north of Carlyle, resulting in  
his death three hours later.
