LETTER FROM TEACHER OF 53 YEARS AGO

E. D. Skinner of Sawyer Receives Letter From Old Time School Teacher Who is Now 81 Years Old.

E. D. Skinner of Sawyer, received a letter from M. M. Walker, of Amoret, Mo., which he prizes highly. Mr. Walker was Mr. Skinner's teacher in Madison township, Hancock county, Iowa, 53 years ago and altho he is 81 years of age, he has retained his faculties to a remarkable degree. Mr. Skinner later taught school himself and a niece of Mr. Walker was Mr. Skinner's pupil 42 years ago this winter. All concerned are still living and hearty. Mr. Walker's letter in part follows:

My dear old friend of the "Long Ago":

It gave me a thrill of happiness when I noticed "Sawyer, N. D." on your letter of the 13th inst. and the card reminded me of its truth that you can't gain a year on me and it carries the same note:

"Days and years revolve but slowly, Time is tedious to the young; In the hope of coming pleasures Off they wish their days were gone.

Soon they fly—they know not whither, Age comes on them unawares; All their hopes and promised pleasures, Passed away with passing years.
