

ILLEGITIMATE CHILD FIGHTS FOR ESTATE

Mrs. O'Brien Claiming to Be a Daughter of the Late John C. McWilliams of Larimore—Brothers and Sisters Want Property.

John C. McWilliams, a wealthy bachelor farmer of Agnes township, Grand Forks county, died March 27, 1919, leaving an estate valued at \$200,000. He leaves a brother, Geo. E. McWilliams, and four sisters, besides several nephews and nieces who claim to be the rightful heirs to the property, and Geo. E. McWilliams has petitioned to be appointed administrator.

Back at Larimore, N. D., thirty-three years ago, John C. McWilliams courted one Minnie Ball and kept company with her for several years but never married her. A child was born to the couple on July 11, 1886, and she is now Mrs. O'Brien, living near Russell, N. D. Mrs. O'Brien has engaged Fisk & Murphy, Minot attorneys, to start an action to get title to the estate. Under the North Dakota law the illegitimate child is heir to the father's property, just the same as a legitimate child.

The attorneys for the plaintiff will prove that McWilliams recognized the child publicly and notoriously as his own.

C. J. Murphy of Grand Forks and Sam Radcliffe of Larimore are attorneys for the McWilliams' brother and sisters.

Minot Merchant Gives Shears-Saw-buck a Body Blow.

A few days since a resident of Minot who had been accustomed to sending to Chicago for his groceries when living on the farm, made out a list of groceries which he wanted and upon the advice of a friend submitted his list to two Minot merchants. A Main street grocer filled the order with what the man considers superior goods and with a saving in price of something like \$2.50. We actually believe that this same procedure if carried out by farmers when ordering groceries in quantities would result in the home merchant getting 75 per cent of the orders that many are sending to Chicago and Minneapolis houses. The frail canoe overturned and Grant went down in about fourteen feet of water. It was very cold and wet. Grant is an expert swimmer and negotiated a safe landing. He did not suffer any ill effects from the plunge, but the water got into his Waterbury watch, which he has been soaking in gasoline since.

Wheat Acreage Short but Conditions Ideal.

W. S. Young of Surrey reports that the farmers are making fair progress with their work. Although they did not get into the fields until about April 20, seeding operations are well under way, some farmers having from 50 to 75 acres seeded to wheat. As no fall plowing was done last fall, the wheat acreage is certain to fall away short, but this means that there will be a larger acreage of barley, oats, speltz, and other feeds, as well as considerable summerfallowing done. The weather is ideal for spring work and the soil was never in finer condition, more moisture having been stored than at any time since 1915.
