UNDERWOOD PRESIDENT NOMINEE

HIS REPUTATION OF W. J. BRYAN MAKES HIM A VERY STRONG SELECTION.

FOR DEMOCRATIC PRESIDENT

STILL MORE IS EXPECTED FROM CHAIRMAN OF WAYS AND MEANS OF THE HOUSE.

Will Further Defend Himself and the Democratic House With Reference to Blocking the Way for Speaker Clark in Revision of the Tariff Schedules.

Washington, D. C., Aug. 3.—Yesterday's repudiation by the House democrats, led by Democratic Leader Underwood, will make the Chairman of the Ways and Means committee of the House a strong factor in the election of a Democratic presidential nominee. Underwood is still strong in denouncing the charges of Bryan with reference to blocking the efforts of Speaker Clark to revise the iron and steel tariff schedules and the matter has been the subject of much comment here today. Still more is expected from Underwood in his defense and the defense of the democratic house.

RETAIL STORES' TRADE IS FAIR

TOURISTS' PATRONAGE AT PRESENT MORE NOTICEABLE THAN IN OTHER SEASONS.

Business in the various retail lines is moving along at about a normal clip for the season. Tourists' demand in the particular channels catering to it, is showing up as more of a factor this season than perhaps in any previous one. Large parties have been coming to the jewelry and notion stores and they are proving good buyers of souvenirs, while their patronage is also a factor in some other directions. Merchants anticipate an active fall trade, and are laying their buying plans accordingly. In the meantime sales to clear out odds and ends in men's clothing and furnishings, dry goods, jewelry and furniture will soon be in vogue. Between current sales and rearrangement of departments, the New York Cash store officials say they are finding matters very active at present.

The store is meeting with a run on embroideries for summer dresses mainly in that competition for marquisettes and voiles. The 43 inch dunes is the thing in embroideries, either in eyelet or plain lace effects. Sweater coats are in demand now for cool evening wear. Fur coats are still the main thing in soft hats. The styles will run in the direction of broad high tops, with some tendency towards lower heels. Button and tans promise to feature largely. At the present a good demand is being met with for lower heels in women's shoes. The trade is considered to have swung largely towards the other extremes during the present season.

MORE STATISTICS ARE GIVEN OUT

CREAM AND BUTTER STATEMENT IS INTERESTING—TREE STATISTICS ALSO.

Statistics of Ramsey county during the year of 1910 which have appeared in 'The World' from time to time as prepared have proved to be very interesting and this will be true of the creamery and other farm statistics. During the year 1910 there were 377,586 pounds of butter made, and 10,690 quarts of cream sold to creameries. Amount received for cream sold to creameries, \$1,177; cream sold other than to creameries, \$7,073. The number of sheep sheared during 1910 was 1,295, and 7,213 pounds of wool was clipped. There were 51 fruit trees bearing and 1,247 not bearing, two acres of trees planted and 1,064 acres of artificial.

Good Fair.
Those returning from the Leeds fair say that each day has an increased crowd in attendance. The fair this year is one of the best that has been held, agricultural products being given an especially important place with a very fine exhibit from various sections of the county. The event closes today. One of the fair features is a series of aeroplane flights by "Lucky Bob" St. Henry, the former Carrington, N. D., man who has been doing more or less work in the aviation business recently in North Dakota.

SIXTH ON LIST OF AUTOS OWNED

RAMSEY COUNTY NEARS THE TOP AND IS LENIENT ON AVERAGE ASSESSMENT.

Ramsey county is sixth on the list at the present time in the number of automobiles owned in the various counties of the state, according to the assessors lists which are now on file at the office of State Auditor D. K. Brightbill at Bismarck. There are 103 automobiles assessed in this county, the total assessed valuation being \$17,650, the average being \$169. At present thirteen of the real property lists have been turned in and there are but five of the personal property lists that are lacking. Exclusive of the thirteen counties, Barnes, Billings, Burke, Cass, Dickey, Mountrail, Oliver, Pierce, Richland, Stark, Steele and Williams, which have not yet been heard from, there are 4,087 automobiles in the state with an assessed valuation of approximately 1,028,550. It is expected that the Cass county report will raise the number considerably and that the total assessed valuation will reach close to \$2,000,000 when the reports are all in. At the present time Grand Forks has the largest number, 312, and Dunn county has the least number, only reporting ten. The valuations are much varied. The Grand Forks county board of equalization placed the assessed valuation of each machine at \$248 and Sheridan county is the most lenient, placing the value of the automobiles at \$51.00.

THRESHING BARLEY AT VALLEY

D., Aug. 3.—The first barley threshing of this locality was reported by Neustadler brothers on the John Emerson farm about seven miles southeast of the city. Al though the barley is rather light, the color is good and it is estimated it will yield from thirty to forty bushels per acre.

LOTS AT FISH LAKE GIVEN

LIST OF AWARDS TO BE MADE TO INDUCE THE DEVILS LAKE AUTO CLUB.

Proposition Would Do Much to Encourage the Good Road Building—Definite Arrangements for Automobile Run Will Probably Be Made in the Near Future.


The suggestion made in 'The World' of a recent date regarding the run to Fish Lake is meeting with exceptional encouragement and unless the plans miscarry will be followed out by the local automobile men. The run would be under the rules laid down by the local club and would be under its direction. Mr. A. W. Tracy, who is financially interested in the sale of lots at Fish Lake, was in the city yesterday and hearing of the proposed run has offered a series of prizes to be awarded in case the plans are carried out. He proposes to give: 1.—To any owner of a car making the run he will give a credit receipt for \$15.00 to apply on the 1st payment on a 50 foot Lake Shore lot. 2.—To every owner of a car making a perfect score he will give in addition to the \$15 prize a receipt for \$25 to apply on the purchase price of a lot. 3.—To the first car in with a perfect score a credit receipt of \$100 to apply on the purchase price of a lot, in addition to the \$15. 4.—If there are no perfect scores made he will give a credit receipt to apply on the purchase price of a lot for \$75 to the high score and \$25 receipts to each of the next six having the best score. Autos to check in at Keavin's cottage at the Lake. Mr. Tracy says all the lots are covered with fine, large trees and are selling for \$180 each. These receipts may be transferred but only one receipt may apply on a lot purchase, unless two are won by the same man. The trip would be one that would be thoroughly enjoyed by every entrant and would aid in the good roads movement.

WHEAT FILLING NICELY.

In his report of Ramsey county this week Commissioner of Agriculture Gilbreath sends the following from Bismarck: "But little rain last week, but with few exceptions the weather remained cool day and night, being favorable for the crops. The wheat is filling encouragingly, also oats and barley. Flax in good shape, fields being in full blossom and a good crop indicated. Corn is making steady growth and a large yield is promised. Most of the wild hay has been cut and stacked without injury and the amount will be large. Potatoes doing well and the crop will approximate the best of large proportions. All other vegetables are in excellent shape. Rain is needed for the full development of the crops. Help plentiful and many are finding employment at harvesting and will assist at harvest. Although the hot spells of previous days will cause a large shrinkage in the yield, the present outlook is favorable for an encouraging harvest."
