### TUCKER BOOSTS SEVERAL MEN

### REPORTED THAT HE WILL MANAGE CAMPAIGN FOR THREE CANDIDATES.

Courtenay, N. D., June 7.—H. N. Tucker, well known throughout the state as the campaign manager of the progressive republican league, will manage the campaigns of Wm. Langer for attorney general, Tom Hall for secretary of state and A. T. Kraabel for lieutenant governor.

This is an attempt to inject into the republican primary campaign the old-time divisional lines among the republicans and progressive and stalwart and split the republicans in order to help the league.

J. L. Hjort, the singing campaigner, who is a boni fide farmer and business man, will be turned down by the progressives. 
