

JULY 13, 14, 15 GREATEST DAYS OF GREAT FAIR

July 13-14-15, the dates set for Ramsey county's first big agricultural fair to be held in Devils Lake, will be great days in the history of the county so far as exhibits, shows, races and all that goes to make a fair a success are concerned.

Hundreds of head of horses, cattle, swine, sheep, poultry and pet stock of every description including the finest of every breed raised in North Dakota will be there, according to Secretary William Guy of the fair association in a statement this morning.

"It will be Ramsey county's first big attempt to hold a fair, and already success is assured," Mr. Guy said. "We are sure of some of the finest exhibits ever seen in North Dakota."

Grain and Garden Produce. "Not only live stock exhibits but grains and garden produce will all be included in the great show. Many farmers have notified the management of the fair they intend to send in samples of last year's crop and samples of growing grains."

Other Exhibits Numerous. Scores of other exhibits including women's handiwork will be found on the grounds. Exhibits of school students' work, and others from every available source.

Entertainment Features. Dozens of entertainment features, free to all, are on the three day program with special attention given to city workers and those from the country who cannot avail themselves of afternoon events. Wednesday evening, July 14th, special races, and a band concert have been provided. On the same day, Al Haines, famous parachute performer, will make a descent from an airplane which it is declared will be flying at the rate of 109 miles per hour when Haines cuts loose. Many other features are free to the general public.
