Provides Apartments For Living Over Big Garage

At least three families will have living apartments in Devils Lake this winter that would have been compelled to move elsewhere or accept hotel accommodations, according to J. F. Quick, president of the Lake Motor company at the corner of Fifth street and Arnold avenue. Mr. Quick, who owns the property recently remodeled into an up-to-date garage, is rapidly completing three apartments on the second floor of the building but already the rooms provided are engaged. J. C. Kallos and W. W. Brown, officers of the Lake Motor company together with Amos Elliott, contracting carpenter, will move into the new quarters as soon as completed.

The plan has been suggested thru Mr. Quick's action, that many places of business in the city could be partially converted into apartments, using space not now available or necessary for commercial purposes, to help solve the housing problem in Devils Lake. It has been declared that even considering high costs of building material and other expenses of remodeling, there are "many such places in the city which could be fitted up as flats and produce a good rate of income from rents, making a fair return on investments."
