**A SKEW FOR ACTION.**  
We think the time has arrived when the farmers of the Northwest should resort to a remedy upon agitation alone as a remedy for the several wrongs which they have been compelled to endure at the hands of one of the most unscrupulous monopolies that ever fastened its grip upon a helpless country. It is true, there were doubts existing in the minds of many as to the real extent of the wrong and whether or not what slightly touched by frost was capable of producing the highest grade of flour. But there is now no room for doubt. That farmers all over the Northwest have been robbed by a systematic course of dishonest grading on the part of wheat buyers. It is a fact beyond dispute that the very best quality of hard wheat is being discounted one or two grades at all the elevators on the "dirty pretext of 'frost bitten.'"

But the question now calmly to be considered is, What can be done in the way of providing a remedy for these grievances and securing to the farmer a price for what something near commensurate with its local market value? Is there any lever that can be got hold of that will place farmers in a position that they may not be altogether at the mercy of an unscrupulous conspiracy between the railroad and the Miller's Association? Individual protests and aimless agitation will accomplish nothing. It will do no good for each farmer to hold an indignation meeting by himself. United effort on some feasible line of action can alone be effective in gaining the desired end. Nor is it the work of a day. The interests that are to be battled are powerful and any movement organized to oppose them must have vitality and permanence. Before any concerted action is undertaken we must reckon on a long fight and a strong one. If any practical, permanent good is to grow out of it.

Before proposing any plan let us consider some well known facts.  
1. The railroad company and Miller's Association are run for the enrichment of a few persons, who have demonstrated their determination to bleed the country as far as they can without provoking dangerous opposition.  
2. Their golden opportunity is when a country is new and ties have not been formed that bind together older communities; when farmers, as a class, are poor and organized opposition is difficult.  
3. These companies will pay no regard to the remonstrances of a poor man, but when a man of wealth and influence demands, on sufficient grounds, a concession or redress he will generally get it.  
4. The history of other sections of the country, similarly situated, as Illinois, Wisconsin and other states, proves that concerted effort persistently carried on will wring from monopolies almost any reasonable concession.  
5. The farmers of this country were this year entitled to an average of at least fifteen cents a bushel for their grain more than they were compelled to accept, leaving an abundant margin for handling and carrying.  
6. We ask our farmers and business men to carefully consider these statements. If they are facts—and we do not think we have overdrawn the situation—then some movement should be inaugurated at once to protect our interests. It is in vain that the country congratulates itself upon immunity from tornadoes and grasshoppers when they are left only a bare chance to subsist, while a few capitalists amass their millions from one season's crop.  
7. Several plans have been suggested from various quarters as to the best means to be employed to bring to a focus the present widespread feeling of dissatisfaction. It has been proposed to hold a mass convention, representing several counties, at some central place. We think, however, that this is not beginning in the right way.  
8. We would suggest that meetings be held in every township to discuss the matters and elect delegates to a county convention. Afterwards a county convention, representing several counties, may be held. Any movement in the direction indicated must start from the masses, though it may afterwards be delegated to the management of the few. There is a great amount of dissatisfaction everywhere which is necessary to measure the real strength and sincerity of this feeling before any deliberate forward movement is undertaken. The question is, are farmers willing to act as well as talk?  
9. The columns of the PIONEER EXPRESS are open for suggestion upon this subject from any quarter.

It is never too late during the winter to remind farmers to make their stables snug and comfortable, if they are not already so. A moderate amount of feed with good care and a warm stable brings stock in good condition for the summer.

"Smuggling" is a new monthly magazine issued from De Smet, Dakota, in the interest of the agricultural church, with Rev. J. M. ... as editor. Though unpretentious, it gives evidence of ability and industry.

We were unable last week to finish the President's message which we give in full this week.  
The first number of the "Mountain Echo" was somewhat missed from our exchanges, but we trust that henceforth we shall not fail to catch it every week. It starts well considering the circumstances, and will doubtless improve with time.  
It would seem to be one of the easiest things in the world to introduce a useful bill into Congress. It is quite a different thing to get it passed, however. In most cases it requires a powerful lobby or an all-powerful public sentiment to crowd it to the last stage.  
The question of the day is "What can the farmers do to protect their interests from the baleful effects of oppressive monopolies and insure a fair return for honest labor?" Can they unite in any practicable line of effort? The best advice we can give is: First, agitate; second, be sure you are right; third, go ahead.  
Senator Blair, of New Hampshire, has presented a joint resolution for an amendment to the constitution, prohibiting the manufacture or sale of intoxicating liquors. The bill provides that should the amendment not be ratified by three-fourths of the states before 1893, it shall then become law by act of Congress.  
The Boston One Price Clothing House, of St. Paul, have recently published a paper for distribution amongst their friends and customers all over the Northwest. That house shows unrelenting enterprise. Should any of our readers, while in St. Paul, have need to visit a clothing house, they should steer straight for the B. O. P. C. H.  
Postmaster General Gresham has made a brave fight against the Louisiana lottery swindle, but the odds are likely against him. The lottery combination has millions of money to spend in influencing Congress and providing means to evade the law. The whole country must take a rest some day from all other questions and turning upon this gigantic swindle clear it out root and branch.

C. S. Hulbert is out in a card defending the course pursued by his company in buying wheat. He would have the people to believe that the P. & H. elevator system has nothing to do with the Minneapolis Millers' Association and that his company is not in collusion with any railroad. It would seem discourteous to question the veracity of an apparently honorable gentleman, but there is cumulative evidence of great injustice somewhere and it is impossible to see how the P. & H. company can be free from complicity in it.

**CORRESPONDENCE.**  
Sir—I wish to call your attention to matters involving the interests of not a few settlers in this Territory. We have in each county in this Territory a clerk of the district court, appointed by the judge of the district, whose duty requires him to hold his office at the county seat and there attend to the duties of said office. The law also provides that he may appoint a deputy to act in his absence or when he is unable to attend to the duties of said office, who has no more authority, however, than his principal.  
The U. S. land laws provide that parties desirous of settling on government lands can appear at the district land office and there make the affidavit requisite for a homestead entry; also, the necessary affidavit for final proof. But if through distance from the land office or disability from any cause the claimant cannot reach the land office, he may appear before the clerk of the district court for the county, who is required to hold his office at the county seat and takes the required affidavit.  
But where does the law in any case give the district clerk a special commission to appoint deputies at will to travel through the county for the purpose of taking final proofs?  
Again, final proofs are advertised to be made before the clerk of the court at Pembina, when there is an express understanding that he or one of his deputies will go to claimant's residence or some other convenient place, frequently many miles distant from the county seat and there take the testimony of claimant and witnesses in some cases.  
Now, Sir, what is the object of a notice of final proof? I should suppose it is that the public should know at what time and place parties are making final proof, so that if any one has any objection it can be submitted then, and it is supposed and intended that they should be made public, so that any one can have an opportunity of knowing what the witnesses are testifying to. I should like to ask what opportunity has the public of knowing what is going on when a proof is advertised in one place and taken in another, fifty miles away?  
In this way the clerk of the district court is practicing a deception upon the land department by representing that proofs were made before him at his office in Pembina, when they were not.
