Proposed amendment of the Constitution of the State of North Dakota.

That Section 176 of the Constitution of the State of North Dakota be amended by adding thereto and making part thereof, the following clause:

The legislative assembly may further provide that grain grown within the state and held therein in elevators, warehouses and granaries may be taxed at a fixed rate.

Proposed amendment to the Constitution of North Dakota:

That Subdivisions 8, of Section 215 of the Constitution of the State of North Dakota be amended so as to read as follows:

Eighth. A state hospital for the insane, at Jamestown, in the County of Stutsman. And the Legislative Assembly shall appropriate twenty thousand acres of the grant of lands made by the Act of Congress aforesaid for "other educational and charitable institutions," to the benefit and for the endowment of said institution, and that there shall be located at or near Grafton, in the county of Walsh, an institution for the feeble minded, on the grounds purchased by the Secretary of the interior for a penitentiary building.

Proposed amendment to the Constitution of State of North Dakota:

Subdivision 5, Section 215, of Act 19, of Constitution of the State of North Dakota is amended so as to read as follows:

Fifth. The school for the deaf and dumb of North Dakota, at the city of Devils Lake in county of Ramsey.
