## HOPE FOR PEACE IN NEAR EAST

Turk Envoys, However, Receive Instructions to Stand Pat on Demands.

### U. S. IS TAKING PART

Complete Accord Said to Have Been Reached by All Delegates—Mussolini and Venizelos to Look After Italians and Greeks.

Lausanne—Hope that peace on earth would result from the labors of the Near East conference was voiced by the speakers at the brief opening session.

This sentiment was voiced by President Haab of the Swiss confederation, who presided over the opening plenary meeting, and it was dwelt upon by both Lord Curzon and Ismet Pasha in their responses on behalf of the numerous delegations.

The first day's sitting required only a half hour and the business of the conference was not actively begun until the second day.

Richard Washburn Child, ambassador to Italy, and Joseph C. Grew, minister to Switzerland, the two principal American representatives, were seated prominently in the front row of the auditorium beside Premier Poincare of France, and received a warm welcome from other delegations.

Mussolini Determined.

The prospects of American activity in the conference, which many of the foreigners appeared to interpret as the launching of a new American policy in Europe and the presence of a strong delegation from Japan, gave world-wide significance to the conference.

Benito Mussolini, the new strong man of Italy, with his air of alert determination, drew all eyes as he moved to his seat not far from Venizelos, whose activities and popularity practically forced the abdication of a Greek king and who was here to apply all his diplomatic skill to save what he can for his country in the peace with Turkey which the conference is to formulate.

It was announced that the establishment of a complete accord between Premier Poincare, Lord Curzon and Premier Mussolini on all matters coming up in the conference, was celebrated by a dinner of 65 covers which M. Poincare and the French delegation tendered to the British and Italian representatives.

It is understood that the difficulty in satisfying Italy arose from the Italian convention that in the treaty of Sevres which the present conference must revise, Italy's national rights in the Near East were not sufficiently represented and protected.

Constantinople—Although some progress was made at a continuation of the conference between the allied generals and Rafet Pasha, the Turkish nationalist governor of Constantinople, complete agreement was not reached on the question of the standing of the allied police.

### NEWBERRY RESIGNS SENATE

Washington.—Truman H. Newberry has resigned as United States senator from Michigan. Forwarded to Governor Groesbeck of the state under date of November 18. Mr. Newberry's letter of resignation, requesting that it might become effective immediately, was made public here after a copy had been transmitted to Vice President Coolidge with the request that it be read into the senate record as soon as possible.

Although declaring in a review of the long and bitter controversy over his right to a place in the senate since his election over Henry Ford, his Democratic opponent four years ago, that this right had been "fully confirmed," Mr. Newberry in his letter said he had been impelled to retire from that body because of the defeat of his Republican colleague, Senator Townsend, in the November 7 election. At the same time, in discussing the controversy in its relation to the campaign just closed, during which it was an issue in many states, Mr. Newberry expressed the conviction that a "fair analysis of the vote in Michigan and other states where friends and political enemies alike have suffered defeat, will demonstrate that a general feeling of unrest was mainly responsible."

Before the case passed as an issue into the recent campaign the senate had upheld Mr. Newberry's title to a seat by a margin of five votes, but it appeared that the fight was again to be resumed early in this session of congress.

### Gets Night Shift.

Keewatin, Minn.—Night work at the Bennett mine, requiring the immediate employment of 250 additional men and an increased payroll approaching \$20,000, was announced here by W. P. Chinn of Duluth, general manager of the mine. The mine is owned by the Picklands Mather company and at present employs 250 men on the day shift. The increased operations of the mine is planned in anticipation of an extraordinary ore shipping season in 1923, Mr. Chinn said.
