The Daily Sun is in receipt of a letter from Rev. S. L. Baugher, former pastor of the East Main street Christian church in this city, but now located at Cherry Run, West Virginia, in which he gives some very interesting wool statistics, but which, perhaps, will not be given much space in the high protective, stand-pat newspapers. Rev. Baugher's letter, in speaking of wool prices, says: Dr. D. V. Frye, near here, has one sheep which sheared 23 pounds of wool, and he sold the wool for over \$7, which is a little better than 30 cents per pound. It would seem therefore that the Doctor isn't losing any money on that particular sheep. But if he is, as the stand-patters claimed that the removal of the wool tariff would drive the wool growers out of business, will some stand-pat republican newspaper please figure out how much he would have lost if we now had a high "protective" tariff on wool and he had sold it at the high "protective" prices of from 14 to 18 cents per pound.—Portland Sun.

GREAT IS ALFALFA

Chicago, Ill.—Members of the American Institute of Homoeopathy concluded their annual convention here last week and adjourned.

Alfalfa as a remedy for indigestion and mental depression was recommended by Dr. Alexander L. Blackwood, of Chicago. He told of experiments made with the new remedy at a Chicago hospital.

The alfalfa is converted into a tincture and administered internally. Its use, according to Dr. Blackwood, was accompanied by an immediate delightful feeling of well being, increased appetite and great improvement in weight.

"Dr. Ben Bradley, of Hamlet, O., also has made experiments with alfalfa," said Dr. Blackwood, "and he believes it to be a coming drug. It stimulates digestion and will prove of great value in dealing with loss of appetite. It does not act as a stimulant in the same sense as liquor."
