GOOD GOLD VALUES FOUND IN OLD MEXICO CAMP

Spanish Miners Made Big Fortunes—Reduction Works to Be Installed.

Torreón, Mexico, Jan. 13.—James E. Boland and O. O. Mattox have just received titles to a large group of mines under the name of La Vaca, located in the San Juan de Guadalupe district near the border line between the states of Zacatecas and Durango.

At the base of the mountains are the old workings, some 200 in all, where the early Spanish miners took out an abundance of free gold. These have since, until quite recently, been worked by the natives who procured the gold by grinding the ore between two stones and washing it in small horn spoons.



EFFORT TO SAVE THE NATION'S LIFE

CONGRESS URGED TO CREATE FEDERAL HEALTH BUREAU

American Health League Presents Facts and Figures—Personal Hygiene a Factor.

New York, Jan. 12.—Showing that over 1,500,000,000 is each year being lost to this country through failure to check preventable disease, facts and figures were today made public in this city by the American Health League, which is urging congress to carry out president Taft's recommendation for uniting government bureaus exercising health functions in one "bureau of public health."

SENENCES PASSED ON SOLDIERS AT FORT BLISS. Fort Bliss, Texas, Jan. 13.—Private Thomas C. Carter has been found guilty of deserting from company E, 8th infantry, at the Presidio, and has been dishonorably discharged and sentenced to serve 18 months at hard labor.

Like action was taken in the case of private Walter McCarty, of the 32d company, coast artillery, but the hard labor sentence was made for 12 months.

In the case of private Zeab S. Longuevan, company E, 19th infantry, charged with absence without leave, the court passed sentence of three months at hard labor, the prisoner to forfeit \$12 a month during that period.
