



ASK FOR REPEAL OF FIRE INSURANCE RATE LAW

El Paso Merchants Want Action at Special Session of Legislature.

El Paso will insist upon the repeal of the present state fire insurance law at the special session of the legislature which will meet at Austin on July 19.

In addition to the board of directors of the chamber of commerce, both senator Hudspeth and representative McGowan were present together with A. P. Coles and H. D. Slater.

A number of interesting points were brought out during the discussion. One was that the 80 percent clause which is being insisted upon being attached to all policies by the insurance companies, is not included in the present law.

Both senator Hudspeth and representative McGowan spoke in favor of the repeal of the law, and the latter asking for information about the rates here and also asking for a statement of the position of the business men on the new law.

MINING AND OIL NEWS.

MORE BOILERS FOR TOMBSTONE MINES

The Consolidated Company's Pumping Plant Largest in the World.

One who has failed to visit the workings of the Tombstone Consolidated Mining company cannot form the most favorable opinion, says the President of the company, of the immense undertaking. The mines are renowned the world through for the liberal production of gold and silver during the early '80's when the output aggregated close on to \$50,000,000.

During the temporary close down, Frank M. Murphy and associates became the owners of a vast mineral property in the Tombstone zone. The Consolidated Mining company and began the arduous and costly task of rehabilitating the old mines. The management was acquainted with the conditions which had defied the ingenuity of modern engineers.

The plan was to sink to the 1000 foot level and then systematically exploit a large area of ground from that depth, cutting through numerous high-grade veins, which were richly impregnated with gold and silver.

To guard against a similar catastrophe the company has purchased a monster Sterling boiler of 480 horse power, which is now being installed and will be in commission in about 20 days. When this battery of 11 boilers shall be in operation the combined power will equal 2484 horses, an assurance that the company will never again be encroached upon by water through scarcity of power.

NEW RULING BY DIAZ ON FOREIGNERS' MINING RIGHTS.

Provides That Foreigners May Acquire Mexico Land, Providing State Can Give Title.

According to the Diario Oficial, the official organ of the Mexican government, the department of fomento has been giving permission to foreigners to acquire real estate within the frontier zone, some prohibitions of 80 kilometers wide along the frontier of Mexico, whether it be public lands or private lands. It is also stated that this practice is irregular which concerns private lands, as the power of conceding these properties belongs solely to the department of fomento.

DEVELOPMENT SHOWS ORE BODIES IN JOHNSON CAMP.

New Equipment Gets Results—Black Prince Shaft Dows 800 Feet—Cochise Company Finds Gold.

Johnson Camp, Arizona, July 6.—The Johnson Copper company, under the management of J. T. Mitchell, has sunk its shaft to a depth of 300 feet. The new equipment, consisting of an engine, air compressor and drills has been pushed night and day, and at a 170 foot depth has encountered what appears to be the beginning of a large body of sulphide ore.

OIL BURNERS BACK ON VICTORIA DIVISION OF G. H.

The locomotives in the Victoria division of the G. H. are to be changed back to oil burners. This order will affect about 25 engines and will necessitate the installation of a number of new oil supply plants, as the old ones have all been demolished.

EL RAYO MINE, CHIHUAHUA, REPORTS 266,498 EARNINGS.

The El Rayo Mining and Development company, operating the El Rayo mining properties near Santa Barbara, Chihuahua, in its report for the quarter ending April 30, shows: Mine ran 83 1/2 days; ore crushed, 13,760 tons; value per ton, \$13.96, United States currency; extraction, 82.4 percent; total revenue, \$188,155. Operating expense, \$98,151; operating profit, \$90,004; capital expenditure, \$11,220; net profit, \$65,598, United States currency.

CALIFORNIANS BEGIN MINING OPERATIONS NEAR NOGALES.

Nogales, Ariz., July 6.—A new mining company, known as the Old Dominion Mining and Reduction company, composed of Los Angeles capitalists with Rodolfo Vasquez as manager, has begun operations on a group of claims near Nogales. The properties are gold, copper, lead and silver and have made good showings.

CHIHUAHUA MINE DEVELOPS ORE RESERVE FOR MILL.

J. Gordon Hardy, of El Paso, consulting engineer of the Gold Mines company of Kansas City, reports that systematic development work is in progress on the Socorro mine of that company in Ocampo, Chihuahua, for the purpose of opening ore reserves before starting up its mill.

CHIHUAHUA BANK GETS BULLION.

The Chihuahua Investment company's bank in Chihuahua has received the bullion shipments from La Republica mining company, 25 bars of bullion valued at 24,500 pesos, and from La Cieneguilla Mining company, one bar of gold bullion, valued at 6000 pesos.
