The force of the explosion blew down all of the timbers in the slope from the sixth lift to the surface. It blew out the mouth of the slope, lifting 20 feet of sand and closing the mine. The fan house was also blown down, but the fan and engine were not injured. Entrance was made to the mine through the second opening, but all the ventilating shafts were being destroyed. It was impossible to penetrate into the mine to reach any of the miners.
