UNSIGNED NOTE TO JUDGE CAUSES COURT DELAY

Writer Alleges Someone Is Making Money Out of a Case.

"Some juror in the case being tried is trying to get something out of it. This note was received by Judge Walthall, of the 41st district court Thursday morning. Upon the convening of the court in the case of J. R. Daniel vs. the Southern Pacific for 50,000 for personal injuries Judge Walthall ordered an adjournment until an investigation could be made at the close of attorney Wallace's argument.

Thursday afternoon Judge Walthall made the following statement: "The attorneys on both sides agree with the consent of the court that two jurors, J. S. Dougherty and S. Eddleman may be excused from the panel. The attorney for the plaintiff is discussing whether to go ahead with the case with 10 jurors or to have a new trial.

"Rumors have come to the court which have been followed up with nothing definite, but enough to excise two jurors."

The case has been in progress since Monday. The evidence had all been introduced and attorney Wallace for the plaintiff had made his argument, and Booth and Brown at the corner of Overland and Kansas streets, is offensive.

UNSIGNED NOTE TO JUDGE CAUSES COURT DELAY

Writer Alleges Someone Is Making Money Out of a Case.

"Some juror in the case being tried is trying to get something out of it. This note was received by Judge Walthall, of the 41st district court Thursday morning. Upon the convening of the court in the case of J. R. Daniel vs. the Southern Pacific for 50,000 for personal injuries Judge Walthall ordered an adjournment until an investigation could be made at the close of attorney Wallace's argument.
