COUNCIL MEETS.

A meeting of the city council is set for Saturday afternoon to consider the claim of the Texas Bitulithic company for paving East Missouri street.

H. A. Comer, general manager of the New Mexico Central railroad, with headquarters at Santa Fe, N. M., is in the city Saturday.

SEVEN THOUSAND PASSENGERS HERE

During the sale of the colonist tickets by the Southern Pacific railroad, from October 1 to 16 inclusive, no less than 7000 people passed through El Paso over that line, going west, according to figures compiled at the Southern Pacific auditor's office at the union station. Ninety-five percent of his number had tickets to California.

On all roads running through El Paso, the number of colonists passing through this city during the month of October will probably reach 15,000. Of this number, however, only a few remained in El Paso. There was never a time in the history of California since the memorable year of '49, when there was such a rush of people to California, say railroad officials.

CATTLE RECEIPTS.

A shipment of 751 head of cattle, which arrived at the port late Friday afternoon, made entry Saturday morning. They were consigned to the Southwestern Stock Yards company and will be shipped to Kansas City for slaughter.

JUAREZ POLICE DOCKET.

The police blotter in Ciudad Juarez, Saturday morning, showed one "drunk and down" man, and the record of a horse being down in the street. The horse was perfectly sober.

MESSAGERS WEAR UNIFORMS

Postal Telegraph messenger boys appeared Saturday morning in new blue suits with caps to match. The uniforms will be required of all the messengers in the future.

STATE RESTS IN STREIGHT

MURDER CASE AT WACO. Waco, Texas, Oct. 22.—The state created a surprise today when it rested in the case of Mrs. Minnie Lee Streight, charged with the murder of her husband.

STARTS FIRE WITH OIL

ONE DEAD AND TWO HURT. Hobart, Texas, Oct. 22.—T. R. Baird was instantly killed, Charles White fatally burned and Carl Sanders seriously burned by an explosion of an oil can at Roosevelt early this morning. Baird attempted to kindle a fire with oil.

DIAZ'S ELECTION ANNOUNCED.

The election of Porfirio Diaz as president of Mexico will be heralded Sunday morning in Ciudad Juarez, according to an old custom. In the absence of mayor Francisco Portillo, J. M. Barella, secretary of the city council, will make the proclamation at various points in the principal street. He will be accompanied by the city fathers.

Mayor Purtillo is expected to return Monday from the City of Mexico.
