MEXICO GRANTS 10 YEAR'S EXTENSION TO THE S.P.

Holdings of Company Consolidated and Prohibitive Zone Established.

Mexico City, D. F., Nov. 28.—All the Southern Pacific Railroad company's holdings in Mexico have been consolidated.

The railroad is required to pay to the government \$1800 per month (Mex.) for inspections, but the government allows \$12,500 (Mex.) for each kilometer constructed.

The road is exempted from all taxation and material for construction is admitted free of duty.

First—A line from Orendaira to Guadalupe and from Guadalupe to Mexico City, passing through the cities of Zamora and Morelia.

Second—A line from Santiago river to the city of Tepic in the territory of Tepic.

Third—A line from Tepic southeast to Magdalena.

Fourth—As many branch lines as the Southern Pacific may think desirable to construct, leading from its main line between Navajon and Guadalupe.

Fifth—A line from Tonichi north to a point on the boundary line between San Bernardino and Agua Prieta.

Sixth—A line starting from the junction of the Yaqui and Mochizuma rivers, passing through Mochizuma and Campas and terminating at Nacorari.

Seventh—A branch line starting from a convenient point on line No. 5 and terminating at a point known as Barranca.

Eighth—A line starting from the station of Empalme, near Guaymas, and extending west to the station of Guaymas.

Ninth—That part of the line which is to be built between the stations of Empalme and Monlo.

Tenth—A line starting from kilometer 422 on the Sonora railroad and extending towards Nogales.

Eleventh—That part of the line remaining to be constructed to reach the point where the Agua Prieta line meets with the existing line between Culiacan and Mazatlan.
