#### MUCH BANKING POWER IS IN CURRENCY ASSOCIATION

Washington, D. C., Dec. 24.—Completed statistics show that more than 32 percent of the national banking power of the United States now is represented in emergency currency associations.

The capital of all the banks in the associations is \$288,957,710 and under the Aldrich-Vreeland law they are authorized in an emergency to issue that amount in notes. The law provides that at no time shall the issue of emergency currency exceed \$500,000,000.

#### CUBA TO RECONSTRUCT SIX VESSELS FOR DEFENCE

Washington, D. C., Dec. 24.—For the protection of her coast Cuba is contemplating the reconstruction of six vessels adapted to coast guard services, according to advice received by the state department. These vessels will have a speed of not less than ten knots and a draft not exceeding six feet.
