CARTRIDGES ARE DROPPED ON RUN
Suspicious Mexican Evidently Trying to Smuggle to Mexico
Smuggling operations for the transportation of contraband munitions of war are being continued along the border in spite of the vigilance of the Mexican patrol along the river. Sunday night a strange man was seen in the vicinity of a Mexican house on the upper island near the El Paso country in East El Paso. He was going in the direction of the river, and when he approached the home of the Mexican, the tenant of the land shot at him. The man ran. An examination afterwards revealed nine boxes of Mauser cartridges, where the man had dropped them.

Jose Eduardo and Trinidad Loya, two others of the alleged Roylata junta who were arrested, waived their preliminary examination Monday morning and are now at liberty on bond. This disposes of all the cases until the grand jury investigation is made. Dorama, Palamaro, Franco, Navarrete, Gomez, Lomas and Hidalgo are still in jail.

POSTAL AFFAIRS ON CASH BASIS

cia envelopes and stamps in the free transmission of official mail, such envelopes and stamps to be furnished on requisition through the agency of the postoffice department. It is to be hoped that favorable action on this recommendation will be taken at the coming session. The desirability of the plan has been demonstrated by its application to the postal savings system. Every letter and package mailed in conducting the business of the system has been required to carry postage sufficient for its weight and class. Thus it has been possible to ascertain the exact amount expended by the government for postage in this new branch of the postal service.

Reorganizing Railway Mail Par.
Another problem of great consequence to the postal service that should be acted on by congress during the coming session is the reorganization of the railways for carrying the mails. During the year the department completed the investigation begun early in the administration with the object of determining what it costs the railways to perform the service, certain of the larger systems, and particularly the larger systems, made heavy profits from mail transportation, certain of the smaller were actually carrying the mails at a loss. The department recommends a plan by which the compensation should be determined on the basis of the amount of space required in cars for the handling of the mails. A readjustment of railway mail pay in the manner suggested, it is believed, will result in saving to the government annually about \$5,000,000.

Reorganization of Railway Service.
Owing to the conditions disclosed by an investigation, a thorough reorganization of the railway mail service has been undertaken. This reorganization, although not completed, has gone far enough to bring about a decided improvement in the service.

In place of the present method of compensating railway mail clerks, which is far from satisfactory, the department will recommend to congress a new system of salaries that will insure regular promotions and a higher maximum compensation for those who render efficient service.

The plan of assigning to the railway mail cars new appointees without previous experience in the postal service is to be abandoned, and hereafter the regular clerks required on the cars will be recruited from the trained employees of the postoffice.

City Delivery Service.
Important changes were also made during the year in the city carrier service. The curtailment of too frequent deliveries in residential sections enabled the department to provide more deliveries in business districts. This policy is almost universally approved by business men, who are willing to have fewer deliveries at their residences in order to obtain more frequent service.

Classification of Postmasters.
The considerations that led to the classification of the position of assistant postmaster in presidential post-offices apply with equal force to the postmaster (itself). A full measure of efficiency in the conduct of the postal service can not be expected so long as the postmasters are subject to political control. The success that has attended the policy of reappointing competent postmasters shows the advantage of retaining the management of the service in experienced hands. In keeping with this policy the department last year recommended the classification of presidential postmasters, and that recommendation is now earnestly repeated.

Fraudulent Use of the Mails.
The department's crusade against the fraudulent use of the mails, begun in 1910, has been vigorously continued. Last year the inspectors assigned to this work investigated a great variety of cases. They secured altogether \$25 indictments, and in these cases 184 convictions have been already secured, with but 12 acquittals.
