DEATH CLAIMS RUE HINES; WELL SUNDAY, GOLD IN DEATH WEDNESDAY

Was Mining Engineer and Secretary of First Mortgage and Trust Company.

Rue Hines is dead. He was taken ill with pneumonia Sunday evening after a golf match at the Country club. Death resulted at 8 a. m. Wednesday.

He was one of the group of young business men of El Paso who are building a city of the future. He was secretary of the First Mortgage and Guaranty company, an affiliated organization of the First National bank. He was also discount clerk in the First National bank. Before entering the El Paso banking fraternity he was a mining engineer in the Sonora and Chihuahua mining fields.

Rue Hines was born in Toledo, Ohio, July 17, 1884, being 27 years old at the time of his death. He was the son of Mrs. Florence L. Hines, who has made her home in El Paso with her son for a number of years. The deceased also had a brother, P. R. Hines, located at Globe, Ariz., who is a mining engineer and a graduate of the Houghton, Mich., School of Mines. An uncle, E. L. Acker, is manager of the Chicago Beach hotel in Chicago.

Young Hines was a member of the Masonic fraternity, having taken his blue lodge degrees in Socorro, N. M., while attending the New Mexico School of Mines, located there. He was elevated to the rank of 23d degree Mason by the Scottish Rite bodies of Wichita, Kan., affiliating with the Scottish Rite of the El Paso valley in March, 1908. As a mining engineer he was active in the mining districts of Sonora and the state of Chihuahua, Mex. His mother then made her home in El Paso, first at the Adelphi hotel and later at the Sheldon, and her son spent much of his time in El Paso when not in the field.

During the past year Mrs. Hines and her son have made their home on Mesa avenue, and Mr. Hines has been connected with the First National bank and its affiliated organizations for the

last eight months. In addition to the Masonic bodies Mr. Hines was a member of the El Paso Country club and an active member of the golf club of that organization. He played golf Sunday afternoon and was taken suddenly ill with pneumonia while dining with friends Sunday evening. He was taken to his home in an automobile and to the hospital Monday evening. Double pneumonia developed and his condition rapidly grew worse, until death occurred at 8 o'clock Wednesday morning.

The funeral will be held Sunday morning under the auspices of the Masons. The body will be placed in a receiving vault here until spring, when it will be taken to the birthplace in Toledo, Ohio, by Mrs. Hines. He was a sincere young man, being the time that he was connected with the First National bank he proved himself to be a trusted and valuable employee," said J. S. Reynolds, president of the First National bank and First Mortgage and Trust company.

S. TRUJILLO.
Coroner E. B. McClintock was called at 8 o'clock Tuesday afternoon to hold an inquest over the remains of S. Trujillo, a Mexican aged 50 years who died Tuesday morning at 202 Eighth street. McClintock gave a verdict of death from natural causes. Manuel Trujillo, the old man's son, arrived here Tuesday afternoon from Las Cruces for the funeral, which took place Wednesday morning in Concordia cemetery.

JAMES FAY GREEK.
The body of James Fay Greek, the former El Paso machinist, who leaped to his death from the 19th story of the Masonic temple building in Chicago, Tuesday, will be taken to Los Angeles for burial. W. W. Greek, of El Paso, father of the suicide, left Tuesday evening for Chicago, and will return with the remains. The deceased was a member of the El Paso lodge of Masons.

WALTER BEEBE.
Walter Beebe, 45 years of age, died at the Plaza hotel on North Oregon street at 8:30 p. m. Tuesday. Justice H. P. Stacy ruled the cause of death

to be heart disease. The deceased leaves a wife. The body is held pending funeral arrangements.

MARIA S. DE GUTIERREZ.
Maria S. de Gutierrez died at her home, 202 Seventh street, Wednesday morning, at the age of 49 years. She is survived by her father, Juan Salazar. The funeral will be held Thursday and interment will be made in Concordia cemetery.

According to this, the feast of St. Patrick will continue to be a holy day without, however, being subject to the law of fasting or abstinence.
