

FEAR ASUNCION IS MENACED BY REBELS

Paris, France, Dec. 22.—The French foreign office is unable to obtain replies to cablegrams addressed to M. Bolla, the French minister at Asuncion, the capital of Paraguay. It is thought at the foreign office that Asuncion, which has a population of about 50,000, has been surrounded by victorious Paraguayan insurgents. The revolutionary movement was started about a month ago.

LYMAN IS SENTENCED TO EIGHTEEN MONTHS

San Francisco, Cal., Dec. 22.—Dr. John Grant Lyman, the Los Angeles land promoter, today was sentenced by United States District Judge Van Fleet to 18 months in the federal prison on McNeill's island, Washington, on the charge of conspiracy to secure from a United States marshal, C. M. Courtwright, a watchman and co-defendant, was given six months in jail.
