SAM MILLIRON FILES A PETITION IN BANKRUPTCY. A petition for bankruptcy was filed today before United States Commissioner George Oliver by Samuel A. Milliron, an electrical dealer and electrical contractor on South Stanton street between San Antonio and Overland streets.
